Artificial Intelligence (AI) is the ability of a computer system to perform tasks that would normally require human intelligence, such as learning, reasoning, solving problems, and making decisions, by analyzing large amounts of data to recognize patterns and act autonomously.

The course of AI in Greece

During the course in Greece we learned the responsible use of artificial intelligence. A practical example was the use of Suno AI, a technology that allows you to create songs from lyrics we wrote.

Suno AI takes the words we enter and automatically generates music or a sung song, turning our lyrics into a complete song. This tool combines human creativity with the ability of artificial intelligence to compose music, making it possible to experiment with new ideas quickly and easily.

Each sentence from the text is shown clearly with a matching image.
